We Choose Health State Grant – update from Danielle

Danielle and Julianne from the Bike Project are collaborating on submitting Letter of Intent for the We Choose Health state grant – due May 18th. IL Dept of Health got funds for the next 5 years to admin these grants to downstate Illinois only. Proposal summary: We would run a twice weekly after school program focused on healthy living for high school students from low income families. They would learn bike building, maintenance and safety, food growing, selection, and cooking, and media production. The media work would be reflections on what they are learning in the hands on pieces. At the end of 2 semesters of work, student will be eligible for several paid summer internships repairing bikes for the Fall run on used bikes and producing media for the IMC.
