## 100+ BOX DWELLERS SLEEPING OUTSIDE FOR A CAUSE

We have simply been blown away by the response this year as we prepare for C-U at Home One Winter Night. **More than 100 people** have signed up to sleep outside in downtown Champaign in a cardboard refrigerator box! Each of these box dwellers is also striving to raise at least \$1,000 to help our friends without an address.

We invite you to be a part of One Winter Night, a HUGE community public awareness event to help the homeless. This is an event for the whole family. Box dwellers will brave the cold for 12 hours, from 6pm-6am on Friday, February 5 – Saturday February 6, 2015. Join our mayor and police chief, city and county leaders, pastors, professionals, students and others, as they spend the night outside in a cardboard box, in support of the most vulnerable homeless. In order to keep helping people with our Drop-In Center, Recovery House, Family House, Women's House, Street Outreach and Transportation Ministry, we have set the fundraising **goal for One Winter Night at \$150,000**.
