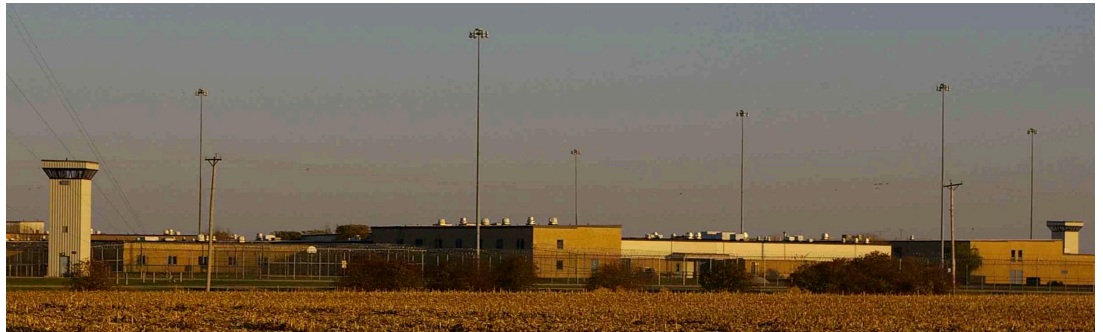


ADVOCATING FOR YOUR LOVED ONE IN PRISON

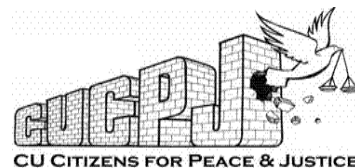
The first workshop will feature special guest Brian Nelson for the Uptown People's Law Project (UPLC) in Chicago. UPLC represents incarcerated individuals in a range of matters, including medical care, excessive force, religious rights, and access to courts; it also works with families. During this two hour workshop Brian will be sharing his extensive knowledge of the prison system, the Illinois Department of Corrections, and how to effectively advocate on behalf of individuals in prison.
