

I Shall Not Hate

A Gaza doctor's journey on the road to peace and human dignity In Urbana-Champaign **February 11-13, 2011**

Izzeldin Abuelaish, known simply as the "Gaza doctor", is a Palestinian physician with a degree from Harvard who was born and raised in a refugee camp in the Gaza Strip, "who has devoted his life to medicine and reconciliation between Israelis and Palestinians" (*New York Times*). Dr. Abuelaish has been crossing lines in the sand that divide Israelis and Palestinians for most of his life—as a physician who treats patients on both sides of the line, as a humanitarian who sees the need for improved health and education for women as the way forward in the Middle East, and, most recently as a father whose daughters were killed by Israeli bombs in Gaza. His response to this tragedy made news and won him humanitarian awards around the world. Instead of seeking revenge or sinking into hatred, Abuelaish calls for the people in the region to start talking to each other. His deepest hope is that his daughters will be the last sacrifice on the road to peace between Palestinians and Israelis. His new book, *I Shall Not Hate: A Gaza Doctor's Journey*, has received high reviews. He currently lives in Toronto, serving as associate professor of public Health at the University of Toronto.
